Quality First Teaching @ Childwall Valley Primary

We strongly believe that the key to success for ALL LEARNERS is quality first teaching (QFT) in every lesson taught. This includes:

- ➤ Highly focused lesson design with sharp objectives (a mastery approach)
- High demands of pupil involvement and engagement with their learning
- > High levels of interest and interaction from all pupils
- High impact of teacher & TA questioning, modelling and explaining
- ➤ An emphasis on learning through dialogue, with regular opportunities for pupils to talk both individually and in groups
- ➤ An expectation that pupils will accept responsibility for their own learning, learning behaviours and independent work
- ➤ Regular use of encouragement and authentic praise to engage and motivate pupils from teacher or TA



Key Themes for CVP Learners in QFT

- **Challenge and Support** (understanding what challenge means in many different forms and having a range of learning to learn strategies to engage and overcome barriers, especially when stuck!)
- **<u>Differentiation</u>** (especially for learners using PIVATS / EHCP requirements / PPP's)
- **Independent Learning** (reducing the dependency on the teacher, learning HOW to be independent to take control of their own learning)
- Learning together
- Questioning and talk (learning how to talk and listen to maximise learning and therefore progress)
